#### Member Updates

Saskatchewan Soil Conservation Association: Board meeting last week and revised vision and mission statements to include conservation agriculture message. Shared products of Consultation with Agriculture Canada and will meet with them soon to discuss further role of agriculture in carbon sequestration.

Ohio No-Till Council: Working on program for Annual Ohio No-Till Conference Dec. 9 and Feb. 26-27 CT Conference. On Feb. 25, having workshop on cover crops and impact on soil quality workshop.

PNSA: finishing conference details and will distribute shortly. Conference will focus on research. PNW is reexamining ARS and University departments where research is conducted and representatives from each will field questions during the conference. Finished strategic planning session last week.

NTOP: Working on conference – Jan 27-28. Planning CAAPAS meeting for August 2009. Involved with air quality task force. Ag will need to begin to look at reactive nitrogen. Suggests getting on mailing list of Calif Farm Bureau to stay informed about developments there regarding air quality standards/requirements for agriculture.
